



Goat anti-Rabbit IgG secondary antibody (unconjugated)

Amount: 1mg (IgG content:10mg/mL)

Form of Antibody: Goat IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg^{2+} and Ca^{2+}), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl.

Storage/Stability: Store at $-20^{\circ}C$ /1 year

Immunogen: The antiserum was developed in goat using the rabbit IgG as the immunogen.

Purification: The antibody is obtained by affinity purified technique, which removes essentially all goat serum proteins, except the specific antibody for rabbit IgG.

Specificity/Sensitivity: The antibody is specific for rabbit IgG. No cross-reactivity was observed with rabbit IgA, IgM proteins by ELISA.

Identification: The purity of IgG was $\geq 95\%$ basing on the SDS-PAGE analysis. The protein content of IgG was **10mg/ml** tested by Lowry method.
