



Goat anti-Mouse IgG Secondary Antibody (peroxidase conjugated)

Amount: 1ml;100 μ l

Form of Antibody: HRP-labeled Goat IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 50% glycerol.

Storage/Stability: Store at 2-8 °C/1 year

Immunogen: The antiserum was developed in goat using the mouse IgG as the immunogen.

Purification: The antibody is obtained by affinity purified technique, which removes essentially all goat serum proteins, except the specific antibody for mouse IgG. Goat anti-mouse IgG is conjugated to peroxidase by means of a method described by Wilson MB and Nakane PK.

Specificity/Sensitivity: The antibody conjugate is specific for mouse IgG. No cross-reactivity was observed with mouse IgA, IgM proteins by ELISA.

Applications: ELISA : 1:5000~1:20000, WB : 1:5000~1:10000, IHC 1:1000~5000
